When I began whispering to my friends and family early last year about an idea I had for an online community where Black women in doctoral degree programs could find, learn from, and support one another, I had no clue that higher education would shift to virtual learning or that Black collective healing spaces would become even more necessary. All I knew was that I wanted Black women who were interested in doctoral degrees to have a strong sense of belonging and community — things I desperately needed during my own doctoral journey.

Since July 2020, Cohort Sistas has become much more than a digital network. It has become a safe and affirming space where current and future Black doctors can be seen, understood, and appreciated. While I am incredibly proud of how far along Cohort Sistas has come in just a year, I am even more proud of how our members have grown personally and professionally. I am more than excited for this next year and honored to be serving this community.

Our work is guided by three pillars — resources, mentorship, and community.



Resources: We held 7 professional development events last year with 8 invited guests and partners on topics such as how to secure fellowships for your doctoral degree, how to choose the right doctoral program, and how a doctoral degree can prepare you for any career. We also shared 50 different funding opportunities for scholars at all stages (applicants, current students, and doctors) and interviewed 26 Black women doctors for the Cohort Sistas Podcast.

Mentorship: We supported 24 students with mentorship through our 8-week doctoral application course and 5-month Sista Circle Mentorship Program. 100% of Sista Circle mentees said their mentor provided them with feedback on their academic & professional goals and 89% said their mentor made them feel less anxious and more confident about their doctoral journey.

Community: Over 6,000 messages were sent on the free Cohort Sistas membership platform, connecting scholars around the world (47 countries represented!). Our weekly writing group attendees have also made considerable progress on their respective writing assignments.

3.1% Campaign: Our first fundraising & advocacy campaign highlighted 31 notable Black women with doctoral degrees. Our generous supporters raised \$6,440 to help provide resources, mentorship, and community for Black women pursuing doctoral degrees!




